## Child Abuse Prevention Month April 2012 Children's Art Contest

### CRITERIA:

- Open to all Northern Kentucky children in grades 3 - 5;
- Children should create a picture related to the slogan: *There is no excuse, for child abuse.*
  - ⌘ Pictures may be on paper size 8 ½ x 11 up to standard poster size;
  - ⌘ Pictures can use any type of medium (charcoal, markers, paint, construction paper, etc.);
  - ⌘ Picture should include a slogan related to the theme Prevent Child Abuse;
  - ⌘ Entries may be completed by an individual child or a group of children (only one prize will be awarded regardless of size of group creating the artwork);
  - ⌘ All submissions must have completed Consent Form signed by parent/legal guardian (attached).
  - ⌘ **Entries should be submitted via US mail or delivered in person by March 16, 2012, at 4:00 p.m.** to Family Nurturing Center, 8275 Ewing Blvd, Florence, KY 41042.

### PRIZE:

The winning entry will receive:

- ⌘ Choice of Hobby Lobby gift card; or pizza party for school classroom, scout group, or youth club;
- ⌘ Public display in April Child Abuse Prevention Month marketing efforts, which may include: art work converted to a poster and displayed on all TANK buses, agency newsletter, website, certificates, t-shirt, print/electronic media outlets;
- ⌘ The winner will be asked to attend the Blue Ribbon Ceremony to kick off Child Abuse Prevention Month on Friday, March 30, at 12:00 noon, hosted by Tom Gill Chevrolet.
