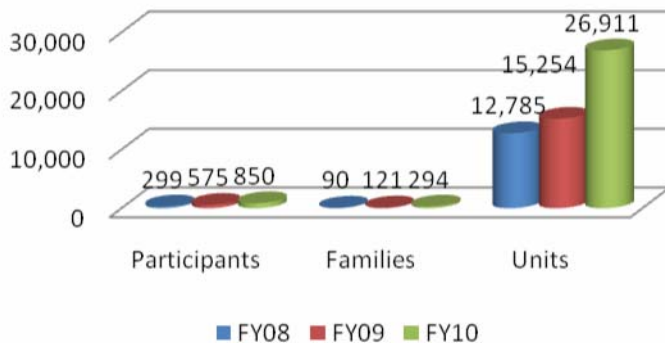


# Comparison of Clients Served – FY08 – FY10

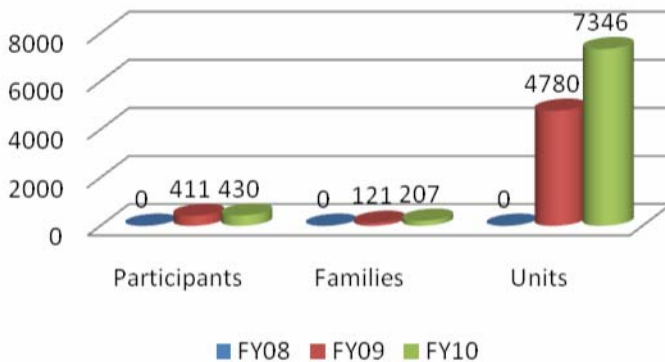
## Facilitated Visitation



### Highlights:

- 76% increase over FY09. Program expansion began in April, 2010 – nearly in the third quarter.
- 80% of clients surveyed agreed that they were benefitting from the program.
- 84% of clients surveyed agreed that the program helped them achieve goals on their JFS case plan.
- 86% of clients surveyed were able to identify 3 appropriate activities to do with their children.

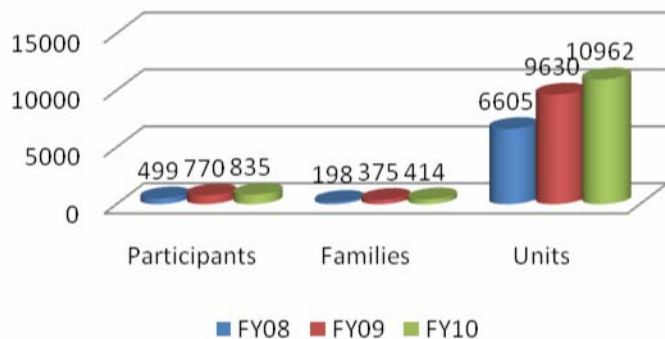
## HOPE Program



### Highlights:

- Program began 11/09 and did not operate at full capacity until FY10.
- 96% of clients surveyed agreed or strongly agreed that they benefitted from the program.
- 91% of clients surveyed agreed or strongly agreed that they learned new skills from the program.
- 100% of clients surveyed agreed or strongly agreed that their parent coach was helpful.

## Nurturing and ABC

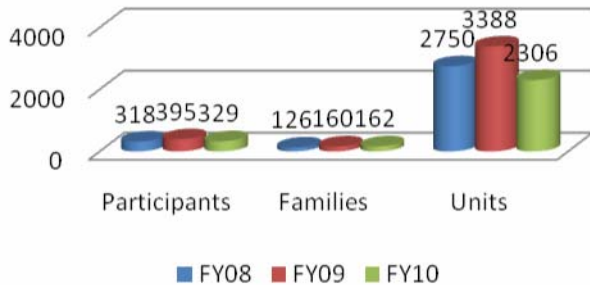


### Highlights:

- 14% increase in units over FY09; 65% increase from FY08.
- 86% of parents/caregivers demonstrated effective parenting skills appropriate to child's level of development.
- 87% parents/caregivers gained knowledge of developmental milestones.
- 97% of parents practice alternatives to corporal punishment
- 87% of parents not currently involved with their child's school will increase their involvement (measured in school based parenting programs only).

# Comparison of Clients Served – FY08 – FY10

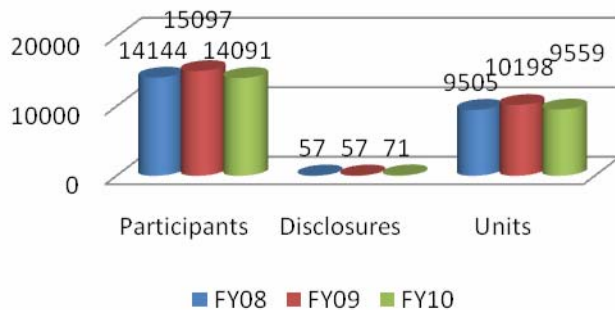
## Child Abuse Treatment Services



### Highlights:

- 75% of children increased their ability to identify feelings related to the abuse at the end of programming.
- 77% of children increased their ability to express feelings related to abuse at the end of programming.
- 73% of children increased coping skills to deal appropriately with the abuse at the end of programming.

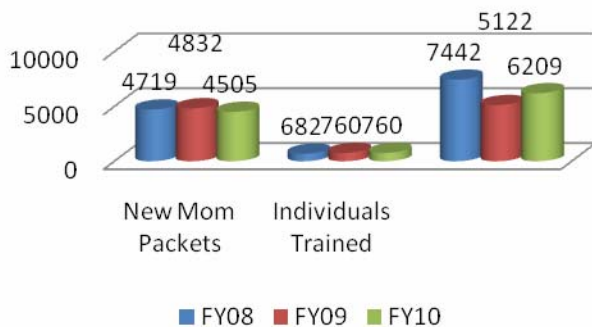
## Kids on the Block



### Highlights:

- 82% of children completing pre and post test increased in their knowledge of ways to recognize, resist and report child abuse.
- 99 of teachers surveyed agreed that the performance was helpful to their students.
- Seventy one (71) disclosures of abuse were received and reported to the Cabinet for Health and Family Services.

## PACI



### Highlights:

- 95% of surveyed parents/caregivers are aware of children's developmental milestones. Parents/caregivers have the tools to prevent shaken baby syndrome.
- 100% surveyed parents/caregivers can identify tips to soothe a crying baby. Parents/caregivers have the tools to prevent shaken baby syndrome.
- 95% of surveyed parents/caregivers tell others about the dangers of shaking a baby.
